FIELD TRIALS AND PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

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Description and envisaged results	theoretical foundations created in WP1. The aim is to develop a version of I AM which is ready to be piloted in four countries (Austria, Belgium, Germany and Portugal). The principles for the field trials will derive from Participatory Action Research (PAR), which implies that besides researchers also teachers, students, parents and members of the countries' school boards will be involved in developing I AM – right from the start. For this purpose, one school in Vienna will be approached and invited to support the participatory development process of I AM. At this school two 'reflective teams' comprising teachers (team 1) and students (team 2) will be established. The participatory process within the 'reflective teams' will be guided by the research team of University of Vienna who will conduct Focus Group Discussions (FDG) with both teams. The aims are to reflect on teachers' current pedagogical practice as well as established diagnostic practices at school (applies to team 1). The FGD with students aims to shed light on the students' emotional, social and academic needs in order to fully participate in their learning environment. The findings of the FGD will be matched with the findings from WP1 and a first draft version of I AM will be developed. In a second phase of focus group discussions (only) with teachers the draft version will be validated. The whole process of participatory action research will result into a version of I AM ready to be piloted in one school in Austria, Belgium, Germany and Portugal. WP2 will further support the practical arrangements to pilot I AM in four partner countries. For this purpose, an implementation plan will be developed that gives strong guidance on formal requirements like securing all legal approvals, in line with national or regional laws pertaining to research with children are involved is a highly sensitive proces, WP2 will develop an Ethical Framework on Pedagogical Assessment to ensure that all ethical standards are respected by all stakeholders involved.
